

The College of New Jersey Board of Trustees Resolution Renaming Paul Loser Hall

Whereas: The current Admissions and School of Nursing Building was dedicated in 1997 and named for Dr. Paul Loser, in recognition of a gift by Dr. Paul Loser's son, and

Whereas: This gift, given in 1987 to help the college realize excellence in the support of faculty and students, exemplifies the extraordinary generosity of the Loser family, and

Whereas: Through archival research conducted by College faculty and students, evidence of Dr. Loser's support and maintenance of segregated schools within the Trenton School system became evident, and

Whereas: In February 2017 President Gitenstein named the Advisory Commission on Social Justice: Race and Educational Attainment to further explore this research and the College's relationship with the Trenton and Ewing Communities and to provide recommendations regarding "programs, actions and initiatives that seek to remediate instances of inequality and prejudice," and

Whereas: The Advisory Commission has recommended and the President has supported and forwarded to the Board of Trustees for consideration, that Paul Loser Hall be renamed.

Resolved: That The College of New Jersey Board of Trustees hereby renames Paul Loser Hall, Trenton Hall, effective immediately.
